Purpose

The purpose of the New Hope Baptist Church (NHBC), Daughters of Victory and Excellence (DOVE), Eula E. Mials Education Fund (EEMEF) is to provide financial assistance and spiritual support to members that are enrolled in a university, college or trade school. The recipient will receive an award no later than August 1, for the upcoming academic year.

The Eula E. Mials Education Fund is not designed to fully support the awarded members, but it is a goodwill offering from the DOVE Ministry of NHBC. Funds are acquired through fundraising efforts of the EEMEF committee, the DOVE ministry, and donations from NHBC family, friends and sponsors.

Eligibility

- Each applicant must be an active member of NHBC (i.e. contributing their time, talent or finances to the support and up-building of NHBC).
- Each applicant must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited college, university. Applicant must show proof of acceptance/enrollment before the award is given (i.e. correspondence from the school, transcripts, etc.).
- Applicant must be a registered full-time undergraduate student (taking a minimum of 12 credit hours)
- Students are eligible to receive funds once a year until they receive their undergraduate degree by:
 - 1. Maintaining a GPA of at least 2.5
 - 2. Updating their application each year
 - 3. Providing proof of enrollment

Application Criteria

All new applicants must complete an original Eula E. Mials Education Fund application, show proof of acceptance, and write a one-page essay. The essay topic: Pick an experience from your life and explain how it has influenced your development.

All applications must be submitted to the Eula E. Mials Education Fund committee by May 1st of every year.

Award

Although the number and amount of awards presented each year depend on the availability of funds, each approved applicant will receive at least \$300.00 each academic year that they apply. Award will be based on the applicant's ability to implement the application requirements and standards. Award recipients will be announced by August 1.

If, after receiving an award, the recipient is unable to attend school as expected for that particular academic year, then he/she is required to return the funds to the Eula E. Mials Education Fund.
